Committee Changes

 - **Communications Team** – website, social media, newsletters, Camping the Kiwi Way magazine
 - **Admin Team** – finance, governance, membership, policy, operations

AGM & Elections Changes

- In line with the club constitution, at the 2026 AGM committee members will be elected to the **committee as a whole**, not specific positions.
- Positions will be assigned within the committee after the AGM.
- Committee nominees must provide a brief resume and outline areas of interest.
